Re-enactors will be camping inside Historic Fort George, Niagara-on-the-Lake. Please come prepared to camp. Firewood, water, & food will be provided to participants.

On **Saturday, October 13, 2012** re-enactors will have the opportunity to participate in the historic march from Fort George to Queenston Heights on the morning of the Battle. (Transportation will also be available for those who do not wish to participate in the march). Later in the day there will be a re-enactment of the major phases of the Battle of Queenston Heights, including the death of Brock, Native skirmishes, and the final phase of the battle. This re-enactment is a once in a life-time opportunity as it will take place 200 years to the day of the original Battle, and on hallowed ground.

On **Sunday, October 14, 2012**, there will be a funeral procession down Queen Street to Fort George; followed by a drumhead service and cannon salute for the revered Major General Sir Isaac Brock and his fallen Aide de Camp, Lieutenant Colonel John Macdonnell. This will be followed by a closing ceremony.
