Over the past 30 years, the 41st Regiment of Foot Fife and Drum Corps has become an icon of Fort George National Historic Site. The Fife and Drum Corps program has been created for youth, starting at the age of ten, and offers them instruction in drill, music and music ensemble. In 2012, Corps musicians also began practicing as the 41st Regiment of Foot Band of Music. This is a unique program to Fort George which highlights the social music of the early 19th Century, using period instruments—flutes, clarinets, serpent and percussion. Donations to the music program will help the Fife and Drum Corps' and Band of Music's programs buy the necessary instruments and materials needed to continue preserving and promoting the role of music in military and civilian life in Upper Canada.

Brock's Monument
